Guidance notes

This form should be used only by producers who send part of their own harvest to another producer, for winemaking through the sale of grapes or for contract making (see Section 2, 3 and/or 4). It should also be used when grapes are sold, despatched under contract or treated at the winery for uses other than winemaking, especially grape juice (see Section 5).

In Section 2, the 'Area in production' should be based on the area under cultivated vines in production during the current wine year **not including** the area used for own production (the WSB 21 figure should be adjusted). Please make sure that this form, when completed, is sent with the relevant WSB 21.

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
